Oracle Exadata Database Machine - History

2008 – Exadata V1: The HP Database Machine

Primarily targeted at a DW environments

2009 – Exadata V2: The Sun Oracle Database machine

Features introduced making it a viable for DW and OLTP

2010 – Exadata X2-2 and Exadata X2-8

Hardware update on Exadata V2

More configuration choices

2011 – Engineered Software Footprint grows. Large part of Oracle Strategy going forward

Gartner on Exadata

- Gartner Research Note G00212953 (9 June 2011)
- Key Findings:

"Oracle's Exadata Database Machine has achieved significant early adoption and acceptance of its database appliance value proposition"

Gartner estimates that some 400 customers have deployed Oracle Exadata, using it for analytics and online transaction processing (OLTP) workloads

Users report positive results with Oracle Exadata, achieving expected improvements in performance and data compression

Skills needed to operate an Oracle Exadata environment must be considered; data warehouse appliances, like other platforms, need design and management

- Customer Experience With Oracle Exadata for OLTP:

They report significant performance improvements

Some clients report that a very large number of applications can be deployed. One client reportedly consolidated 400 applications onto the platform







Forester Research Report – Key Findings

- According to Forrester's November 2010 Global Database Management Systems Online Survey, 65% of enterprises find delivering performance a top database management challenge.
- Most customers stated that Oracle Exadata exceeded performance and high availability requirements to support their missioncritical applications -5x to 40x performance gains
- Oracle Exadata's hardware and software components are integrated to improve performance and achieve high availability for OLTP and data warehousing

Forrester finds that most customers are benefitting from improved manageability compared with traditional database platforms. Up to 20% lower administration cost

Ability to grow and scale as needed

Oracle delivers a scalable Exadata platform that starts out as small as a quarter rack and grows to a full eight-rack configuration

• Oracle Exadata can support any type of database workload, ranging from data warehousing, data marts, and operational data stores to analytical and transactional applications.

Oracle Exadata runs packaged applications such as Oracle E-Business Suite(EBS), SAP, Oracle PeopleSoft, and Oracle Siebel applications without modifications

Oracle Exadata can consolidate many databases to lower cost and improve manageability.

Estimates that more than 250 customers are currently using Oracle Exadata. This is likely to triple in the next 12 to 18 months


